WELCOME TO THE 2023 JR. MISS I-500 PAGEANT!

Jr Miss contestants will wear a floor-length evening gown. Please do not spend a lot of money on a dress that will only be worn for a few minutes on stage! Borrow an older sibling or friend's old prom dress or visit a local thrift store. I also have several donated dresses to give away, so call me to make arrangements to try some on! Jr. Miss contestants will model their evening gown and answer one question on stage. They will also turn in the questionnaire that is included in this packet. It is recommended that you type your answers. You can either copy and paste the questionnaire into a word document, or simply staple the questionnaire to your typed answers. They will get to “practice” for the Miss International age division by doing a “mini interview” with the judges prior to the start of the pageant. Please also include a resume. We realize that 12-16 year olds don't have a lot of work experience to put on a resume, but this is also good practice for the Miss International division. List things like your school achievements, extra curricular activities, any honors or awards, and any volunteer work or community service you have done. Jr. Miss contestants must also bring a small prize for each candidate in her division to be added to the gift bags. You will receive an e-mail the week before the pageant letting you know how many items you will need to bring. This is just a fun way to keep the competition friendly and does not need to be expensive. Jr. Miss contestants will compete for an “audience choice” trophy just like the Miss International 500 contestants do. (Information will be provided below.) The registration fee for Jr. Miss is \$40 and will cover the cost of crowns, sashes, and prizes for all contestants. You will also need to submit one photo of yourself which will be scored based on age appropriateness. You will also need to decorate a coffee can with lid (cut a small hole in the lid making it like a “piggy bank”) and put your name and photo on it to be used in the Audience Choice competition.

This year's pageant will be held on Friday, February 3rd at 7:00p.m., at the Dream Makers Theater in the Kewadin Casino. Please plan to arrive by 5:30p.m., to start interviews.

Each contestant must decorate a coffee can with lid to be displayed at the back of the theater during the pageant with her name and photo on it. The audience can vote for you by putting money in your designated container. The contestant with the highest dollar value in her container at the end of the pageant will receive the Audience Choice trophy. This is JUST FOR FUN and a great fundraiser for the Pink Ribbon Riders! 100% of the money collected via the Audience Choice vote goes directly to the breast cancer patients that Pink Ribbon Riders assist financially. In order to raise as much money as possible for this worthy charity, you will be permitted to start collecting “proxy votes” as soon as your application packet is turned in. Ask your out-of-town friends and family, classmates, etc to vote for you by making a donation to the Pink Ribbon Riders!

Collect the money in your decorated can and turn in to the pageant director before the start of the pageant.
